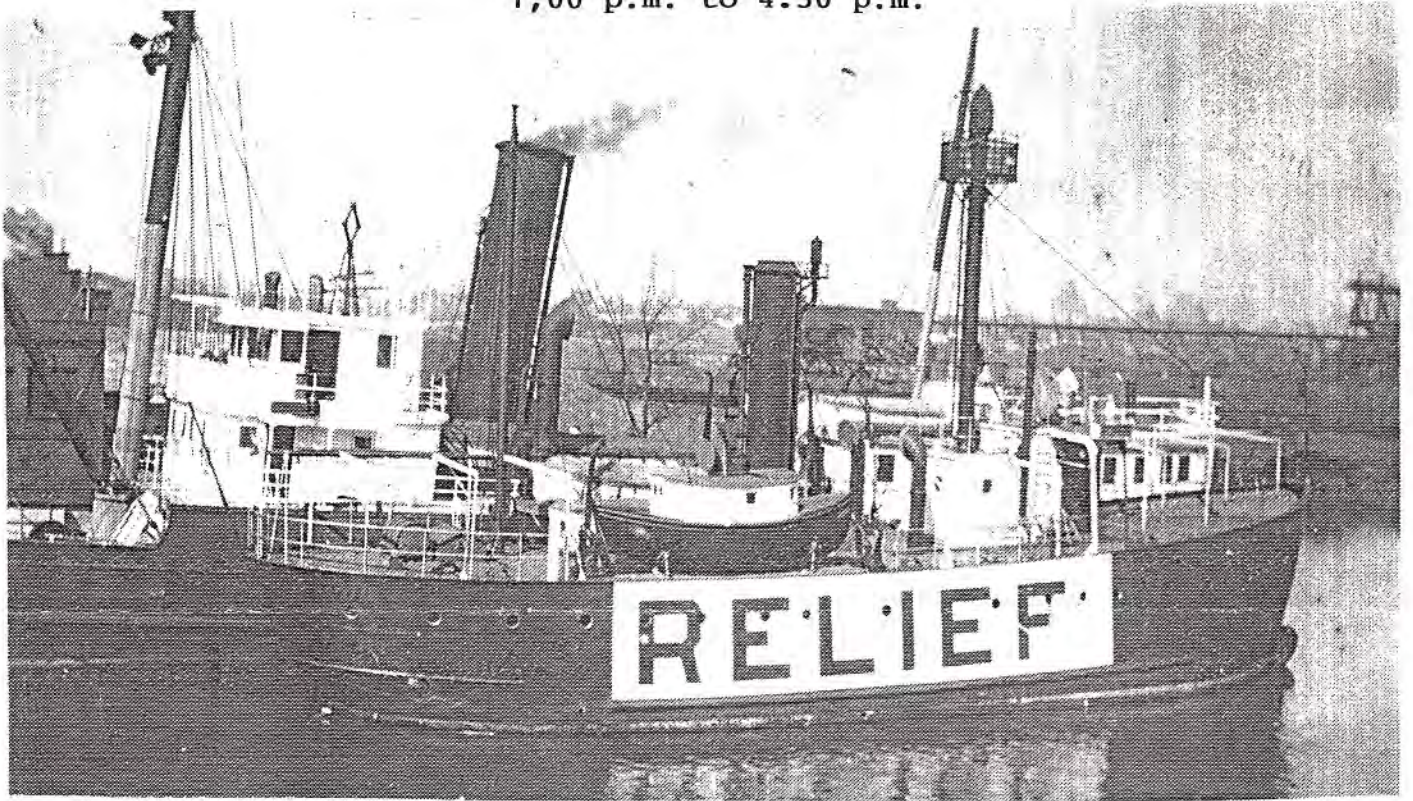

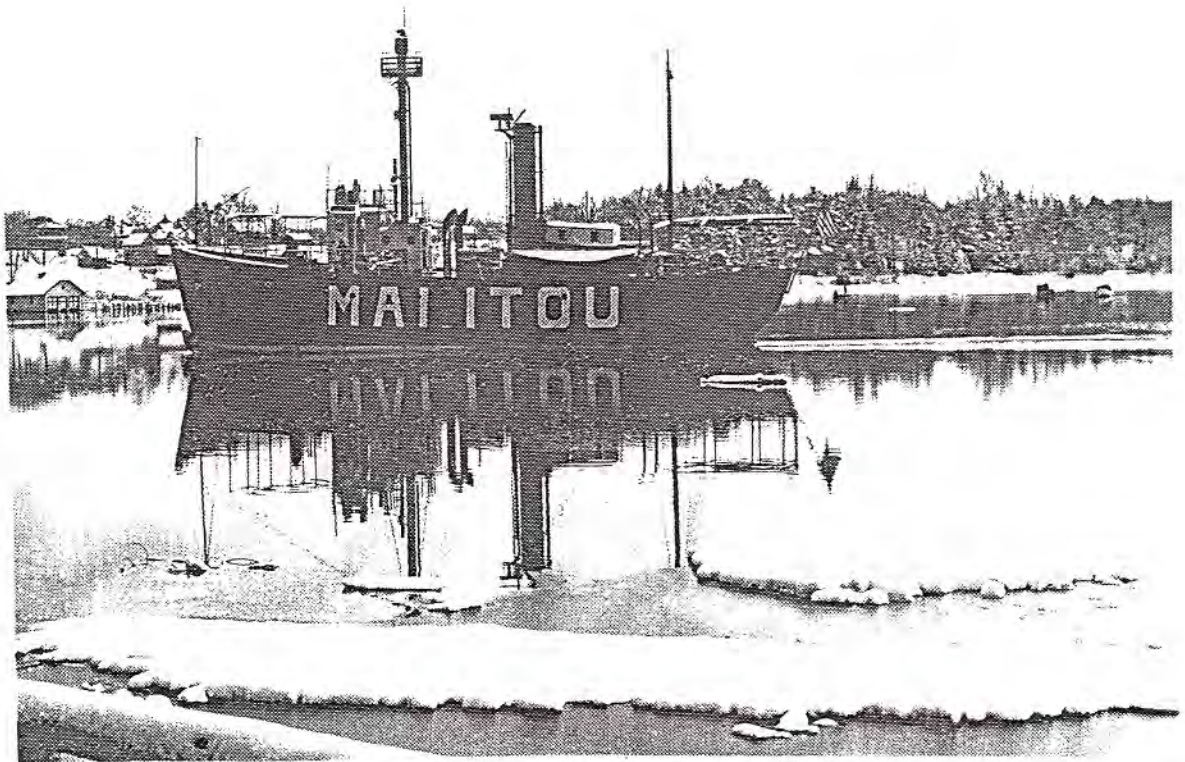
AS HURON ON STATION IN HER STEAMSHIP DAYS

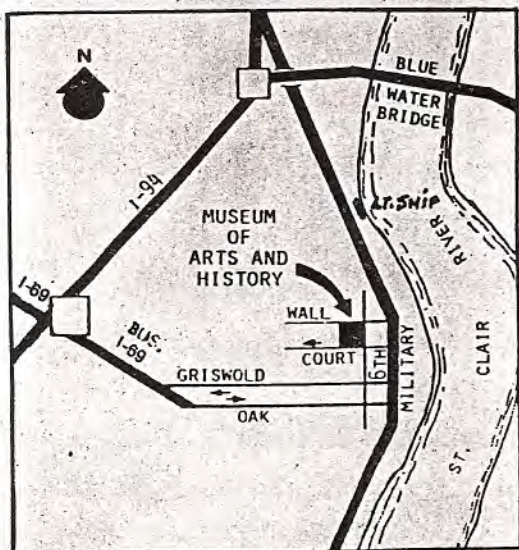
At this time when State budget cuts are hitting us hard, the Museum can really use your help more than ever. Lake Huron Lore - the Museum - and you...we make a great team!
